Market Update

The Singleton market performed well throughout the Winter with plenty of buyer enquiry from owner occupiers and investers alike. The Upper Hunter remains in the top 10 with regard to regional NSW median value growth, currently sitting at +8.4% over the last 12 months (see table below).

We continue to see local buyers compete with those from out of the area who are looking for either an investment or home to move into. It has been reported that 41,000 (mostly young) people have left Sydney for the regions over the last 12 months due to the ongoing cost of living crisis, with the Hunter Valley seeing a 14% increase in the number of people moving to the area. The outlook for housing values remains positive as we head towards the last quarter of the year, supported by an outlook for lower interest rates, improving buyer confidence and short housing supply.




